368	<p>Offering free and confidential testing through community events, by appointment and Wednesday evenings in our Uptown office (5 to 7 PM) in partnership with the Health Department.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our outreach team performed 173 HIV tests and everyone tested was referred for follow up interventions depending on their individual needs. Through our partnership with the Mecklenburg County Health Department, we provided office space for them to perform HIV/STI tests for an additional 195 people for a total of 368. This partnership allows easy access for people working in the uptown area as well as the community's homeless population.
